Creative:

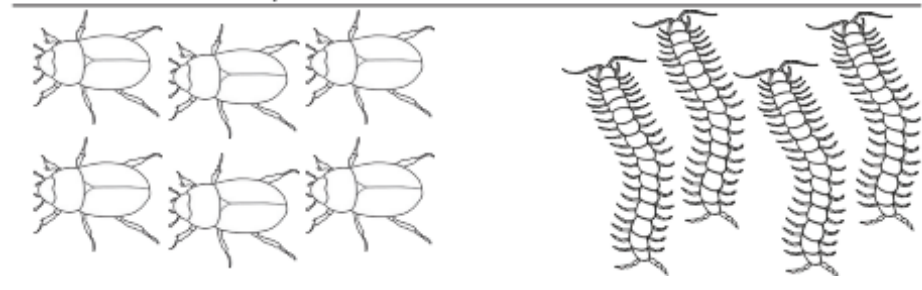
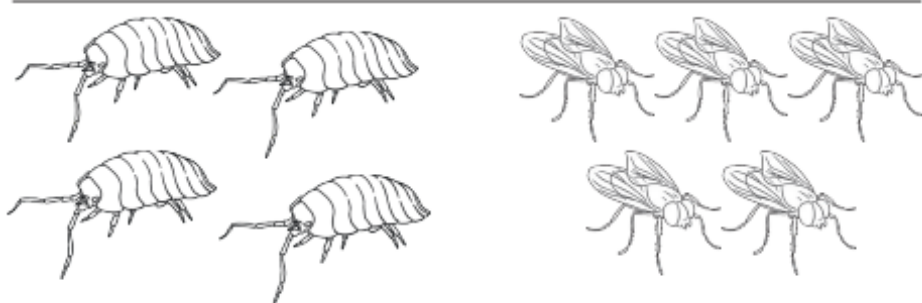
