Create a new species of bird! Consider its name, appearance, size, habitat, diet, life cycle and any other interesting facts and information. Present your work as a poster, information booklet or power point and include diagrams, labels, text and pictures. Be creative and use your imagination, but remember that your bird must have the same characteristics and features of all birds, e.g. lay eggs and have feathers!

Maths

Use Mathematics to practise individual areas of weakness from class tests. Attend Maths boosters and do homework given!

Geography – Our topic this half term is Fair Trade.

1. Choose 3 items from your home, find out the country that they were manufactured in. Consider the journey they have made to your home. Write a diary entry detailing this, mention place names and details of the journey.
2. Consider how trading has changed over time. How did the British Empire affect trade? How did the Tudors/ Victorians trade? Contrast transport. Present this as a poster or power point.

Creative – Our DT topic this half term is Seasonal Food

1. Create a seasonal food calendar
2. Create a collage from different food packaging

Literacy – We are looking at the historical novel, The children of the King this half term.

Make a fact file or poster about the Blitz. Include facts, pictures and information.

Chose a Literacy, Science, Creative and Geography task to complete at least 4 tasks in total, Mathematics assigned tasks are compulsory.
