Create a NUMBER FLOWER. This involves using a number in the centre of your flower and then all the ways to represent it on the petals e.g.

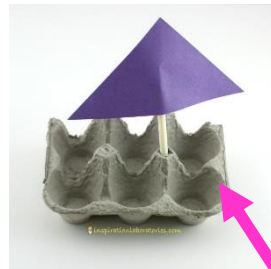
10 in the centre. You could show in a tally, tens frame, sums and more!
