

Science – What changes would you like to see humans evolve?

For example:

- A button to switch off pain
- A detachable third eye to see what you look like without a mirror
- 'Grippy' hands and feet so that you could climb walls like a lizard!

Be creative and think of at least 5 ideas.

Describe and illustrate your ideas with drawings and diagrams, and include short explanations. You can present your work in any way you choose.

Maths

Create a questionnaire to collect data, this can be any data of your choice. Create a bar chart and a pie chart to display your data. Explain what your data shows.

Geography – our topic this half term focuses on climate change

- Explain some ways that the weather can change a landscape. Create a poster using pictures of different landscapes, these can be drawn or photographs. It would be great if you include places that you have been to.
- Look at the weather forecast for hourly temperatures for a day. Create a line graph to display this information.

Literacy

- Write a biography on a person of your choice.
- What makes a good leader? (RE link) Write a persuasive argument for why you should be a leader, for example of a football team, a school, the country! Sell yourself and your talents!

Creative – our Art topic this half term focuses on printing techniques.

- Create a factsheet or powerpoint about the artist Andy Warhol or Roy Lichtenstein
- Explore printing with different natural objects; can you create your own printing block out of cardboard, foam or natural materials?
